- 0415 RIG SLIP FOR ACTION. RIG FOR TOWING. RIG FENDERS FOR GOING ALONGSIDE OTHER SHIPS. READY ANCHOR.
- 0445 (about) GENERAL QUARTERS.
- 0520 ANCHOR. Commence Bombardment.

NOTES: 1. Today will prove to be a very busy one for the mighty De HAVEN. We will be at General Quarters up to possibly 18 hours. All hands are expected to understand the inconveniences encountered and are reminded that this will probably be the only day during which we have to do it the hard way.
