PLAN OF THE DAY

Uniform of the day - Clean regulation dungarees with White Hats.

0530 Call all mess cooks.  
0545 Call all leading Division Petty Officers.  
0600 REVEILLE.  
0630 Breakfast.  
0700 RIG SHIP FOR ACTION. RIG FOR TOWING. RIG FENDERS FOR  
GOING ALONGSIDE OTHER SHIPS. READY ANCHOR.  
0800 Muster on station.  
0945 Serve coffee and sandwiches in messhall.  
1100 (about) GENERAL QUARTERS.  
1300 ANCHOR. Commence Bombardment.  
1445 Underway.  
1700 Supper.  
1930 Make 8 o'clock reports.  
2030 TAPS. Lights out in all living compartments.

NOTES: 1. All hands prepare for ACTION.  
(a) Shower, shave, cut and clean finger nails.  
(b) Wear complete change of clean clothes - underwear,  
socks, dungarees. At battle stations tuck trouser  
legs into socks, shirt collar and sleeves buttoned.  
(c) All personnel in exposed areas topside wear kapok  
life jackets and helrets.  
(d) There will be no sightseers. All hands remain at  
their own battle station.
