

USS DeHaven Sailors Association Scholarship Program

Scholarship Program Administration

1. A Scholarship committee consisting of five (5) or more members of the USS DeHaven Sailors Association will be established to evaluate applications. Each member of the committee will evaluate each application and provide a numerical rating. The highest rated applicants will be awarded a scholarship
2. At the annual business meeting, the Scholarship committee will announce the names of the winners for that year. The Association Treasurer and Committee Chairman will determine the number of scholarships to be awarded for the year following the general meeting.
3. Monies earmarked for the Scholarship Program will be accounted for separate from other monies of the Association. The Association President, Vice President and Treasurer will have check writing authority for these funds.
4. Each Scholarship will be awarded for one year and will have a value of \$1000. It will be paid to the school of the applicants choice for books, room and board, tuition, or other school related expenses
5. The DeHaven Scholarship Program also offers and second and third year scholarships to those who desire to re-apply. Second and third year scholarships will be awarded for one year and each will have a value of \$1000.

Scholarship Criteria

1. Applicant must be the son, daughter, grandson, granddaughter, etc. including those by marriage of an active dues paying shipmate of the USS DeHaven Sailors Association. If the shipmate is deceased, he must have been an active dues paying member before his death.
2. Applicant must be a senior in high school that has been accepted to an accredited trade school, college, or university or enrolled in an accredited trade school, college, or university.
3. Applicant must have satisfactory grades, attendance, and disciplinary records verified by a school official (i.e.; Teacher, Principal, or other official).
4. Applicant must be a well rounded individual, active in community affairs such as, church, sports, Scouting, or charities.
5. Applications must be received by July 31 of each year.
6. Applicants that wish to continue to participate in the DeHaven Scholarship Program must reapply each year for the second or third year award. Applicants must forward a cover letter stating that intention. The letter should include the applicants name, address, email address, any change in the applicants major, current GPA, cumulative GPA, and any pertinent information the applicant may want to add. A copy of the applicant's transcript for the entire school year must be included. The entire package must be received by July 31 of each year
7. In the event of the passing of the Shipmate, the scholarship application form may be signed by the Shipmate's spouse or immediate family member. Failing that, authorization for the required signature will be at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee.
